The largest part of students' lives is spent on working on projects, preparing assignments and presentations and of course, on top of this, preparing for exams. Here are some things about study groups.

There are two main reasons why students might avoid taking part in a study group. First, there is the reason based on the belief that an isolated environment is necessary for better concentration. This might be true if you want to learn the material by heart. If you want to understand what and why you are studying, group study is undoubtedly superior compared to self-study. The second reason is something we are often aware of but refuse to accept. This refers to the fact that when studying in a group, you become in danger of having to face the things you are not so knowledgeable about.

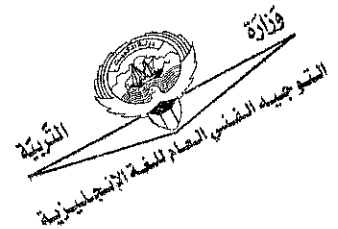
Study groups are better than self-study for the following reasons. The first reason is related to the last point about why people are not eager to form study groups and rather self-study. That is, when you are studying in a group there is a higher chance that most of the things you are uncertain about will come out. Although it is annoying, it is better to face your weak points in good time. Secondly, it is often quite hard to understand every detail of the lecture when doing self-study. However, some classmates of yours might have paid more attention to the parts you missed, and so, you can all help to fill in each other's gaps. The best way to really learn and understand a certain point is through explaining **it** to others. Thirdly, study groups promote critical thinking and creativity. So, this interactive environment ensures a much deeper learning of the material that would be missed with self-study. Finally, when you are alone, the temptation to postpone is bigger than when in a study group.

What makes an effective study group? Here are some tips to help form an efficient study group. Work with the people that motivate you rather than those that are only looking for an easy way to get a passing grade. Look for those that are prepared and focused in class and that are asking questions and answering teachers' **inquiries**. If too many people take part in a study group, it becomes more difficult to coordinate and communicate with all members. So, an ideal size of a study group is around three to four people.

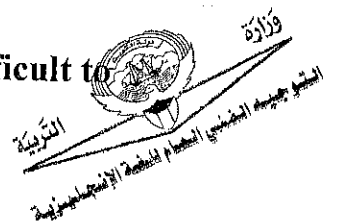
