Block, walk and turn; that's what hearing doctors want you to do when you come across a really loud noise. Block the noise from entering your ears; walk away from it; and turn it down. Those are your first steps in staying **safe**. Doctors think that, 15% of all school-age children live with some hearing loss. And it's a growing problem.

There are two types of dangerous noises: sounds that are too loud and sounds that last too long. Both types can be very bad for some parts in your brain. Most people don't know that listening to headphones at full volume is really dangerous. Doctors say that "If your stereo is too loud and if you listen to **it** every day, it is really bad for your hearing." If your neighbours use noisy machines, close your windows and doors to block the sounds. This will protect your ears. Adding mats and carpets can be useful, too.
