They attended schools regularly but learned about science and mechanics from reading and working with equipment. In 1892, **they** started shops in Dayton, Ohio, where they rented, sold, and built bicycles.

Wilbur and Orville Wright began to test a new type of airplane in 1900. They **designed**, built and tested over two hundred models to choose the best design. Finally, they designed one on which the pilot would lie down flat on his body. They tested their design one thousand times over three years on the sand hills near Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. During this time, they were becoming very good pilots.

On December 17, 1903, Orville and Wilbur Wright tried the invention on a beach at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. Operated by a small engine, the airplane moved across the sand and flew a total of one hundred and twenty feet into the air before landing. Orville and Wilbur Wright are remembered as the "Fathers of Flight." The beach at Kitty Hawk is a national historical place.
