Tea is one of the most popular drinks in the world. Tea is prepared from the leaves. Over three million of kilograms are grown yearly worldwide. They grow on high lands in India, China, Japan and Sri Lanka. Tea plants provide us with different types of tea such as black, white, yellow, and green tea.

In India, there are many tea gardens in a town called Darjeeling. Darjeeling tea is special for its fine flavour and nice taste. It's best enjoyed during the morning or early afternoon, but not in the evening because it has a lot of caffeine.

Tea plants are planted by the farmers in lines with **gaps** of one to two metres from one another. They grow about two-metre tall and sometimes can reach 9 metres. The leaves of the plant are about 5 centimetres long, and its colour is dark green. They usually grow in oval shape.

The tea leaves are pulled from plants three or four times a year. The leaves are put in baskets in the sun to dry for many hours, and then heated over fire. After heating, the leaves become very dry, hard and ready for drinking. **They** are then packed in wooden boxes and sent to the market for selling.
