The week before it died, Alex was working with Irene on **difficult** words. On Thursday, Irene said that Alex looked at her and said, "Be good. See you tomorrow. I love you." It died in its cage the next morning.

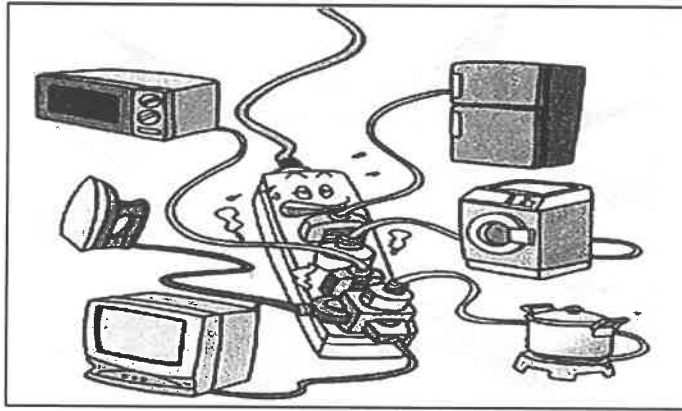

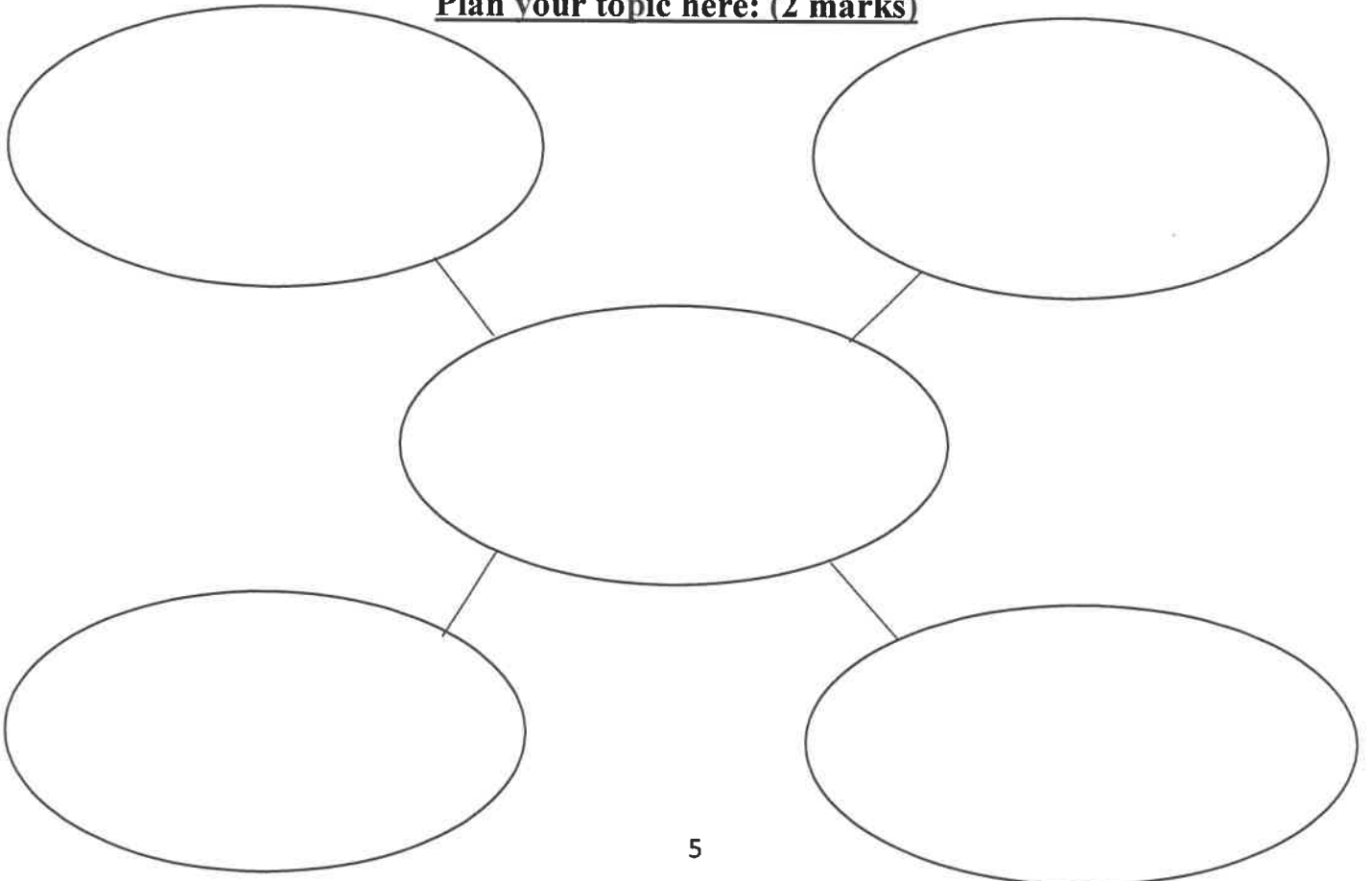

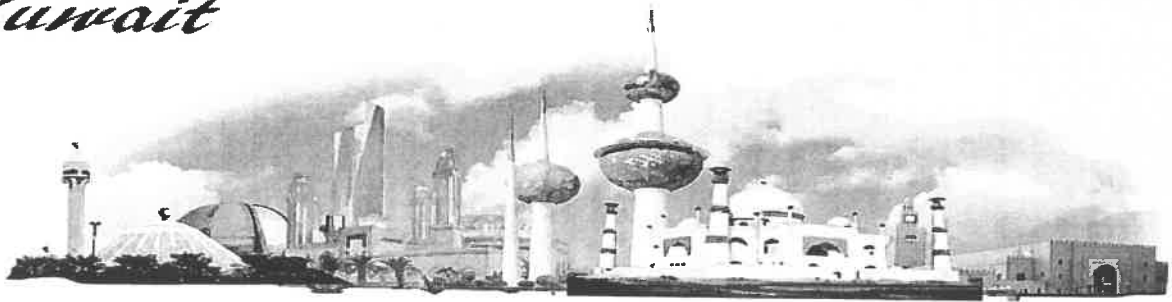
